Minyan B'Yachad

We are a member of the United Synagogue of Conservative Judaism and an accredited Framework of Excellence school. This requires us to meet 2 afternoons a week in addition to Sunday classes. Because we only require class on Sunday and one day during the week (Tuesday or Wednesday), we must make up for the lost second day.

Minyan Katan

Gan K – Bet 2 students and parents are invited to attend their very own service this year. It will meet 8 times and will coincide with either Tot Shabbat or Minyan B'Yachad. The service will begin at 10:15am and will join Minyan B'Yachad at 11:15am for the culmination of their service.

Gimel 3 – Vav 6 are required to attend a minimum of at least 10 Minyan B'Yachad services in addition to 5 other services (Friday evening service or Saturday morning) which can be in our main sanctuary or at other synagogues. Please remember that students in Vav 6 are required to complete 10 Minyan B'Yachad services regardless of their B'nai Mitzvah date.

Zayin 7 students are required to attend services once a month beginning one year prior to their B'nai Mitzvah.

When attending services, students are required to pull their attendance card so they can receive credit. There are three sets of attendance cards, one for Minyan Katan, one for Minyan B'Yachad and one for the Main sanctuary. There will be separate cards for Zayin 7 students as well.
