### Registration Fee:

- Early Bird Discount: \$465 Due by June 20, 2008
- General Registration: \$495 Due by July 18, 2008

Registration fee includes 7 days and 6 nights at the beautiful Capital Camps in Waynesboro, PA. All Kosher meals, snacks, programs (including a day trip to Hershey Park!), supplies, transportation and Encampment t-shirt are included.

### Sibling Discount:

Register your first child at the regular registration price and register each additional child at 10% off the registration price (may be used in combination with the early bird discount).

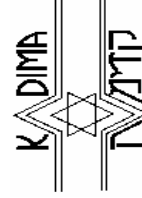
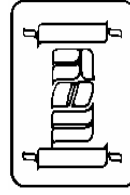

## OVER 200 ACRES OF WOODS AND WATERFRONT...

**C**apital Camps, home of the USY Encampment and Kamp Kadima, is located in Waynesboro, PA. Capital Camps is nestled between two picturesque lakes and amenities include sports fields, a ropes/challenge course, hiking trails and an aquatic center with a 5,500 square-foot heated pool, diving board, two 40' water flumes and water-play features. Campers are grouped according to grade, in cabins that are equipped with bunk beds, shelf space for each camper, closets and indoor bathroom facilities. Each cabin has approximately 12-14 campers and 1-2 staff members.

### ENCAMPMENT PROGRAMS...

- Kamp Kadima for teenagers entering the 6th through 8th grades in the Fall.
- USY Encampment for teenagers entering the 9th through 12th grades in the Fall.
- Staff Training Seminar (STS) for first time staff members who have completed their freshman year of college.
